Job Description

In this permanent, full-time role, you will be based at the Urgent Primary Care Centre, 1290 Hornby Street, Vancouver.

Overview

The Urgent Primary Care Centre is designed to support patients who need urgent access to primary care services. The primary function of the centre is to assess, diagnose, and treat non-life-threatening illnesses. The centre is supported with an onsite lab, diagnostic imaging tools, and a pharmacy.

Core Responsibilities

- Evaluation and management of the Urgent Primary Care patients.
- Diagnose and provide treatment to patients who have not yet been diagnosed with disorders, diseases, and other conditions that may fall within the scope of the Nursing Practitioner.
- Primary liaison between the nursing team and the physicians.
- Provide orders for medications and treatment, delivering first-line care when an emergency situation arises.
- Co-ordination and implementation of patient care plans.
- Close collaboration with members of the healthcare team to arrange referrals and follow-up care if needed.
- Casting and suturing as required.
- Admission and discharge of patients in accordance with policies and regulations.
- Ongoing care monitoring, ordering diagnostic investigations, and the ability to understand and interpret investigation reports, carefully analyzing information to plan treatment and monitor progress.
- Accountability for the comprehensive assessment of patients.
- Initiation of treatment including therapeutic interventions, healthcare management, and medication prescriptions in accordance with the regulatory standards, statutory limits, and procedures.
- Assign nurses and other healthcare personnel, perform evaluations, and deliver education within a supervisory capacity as required (for supervisory positions only).
- Quality improvement and control.
- Set out relevant health management priorities concerning health, disorders, diseases, and conditions.
- Provides professional guidance to other health professionals.
- Communicate with family, residents, and patients regarding any findings, diagnosis, and any other priorities, support, outcomes, and counsels.
- Participation in nursing educational activities that may include presentations, mentoring and enabling the sharing of knowledge amongst the team, driving knowledge exchange within the community and the clinical setting.

- Sustain a focus on population health through the implementation of health screening and other promotional activities.
- Conducts other duties as assigned.
